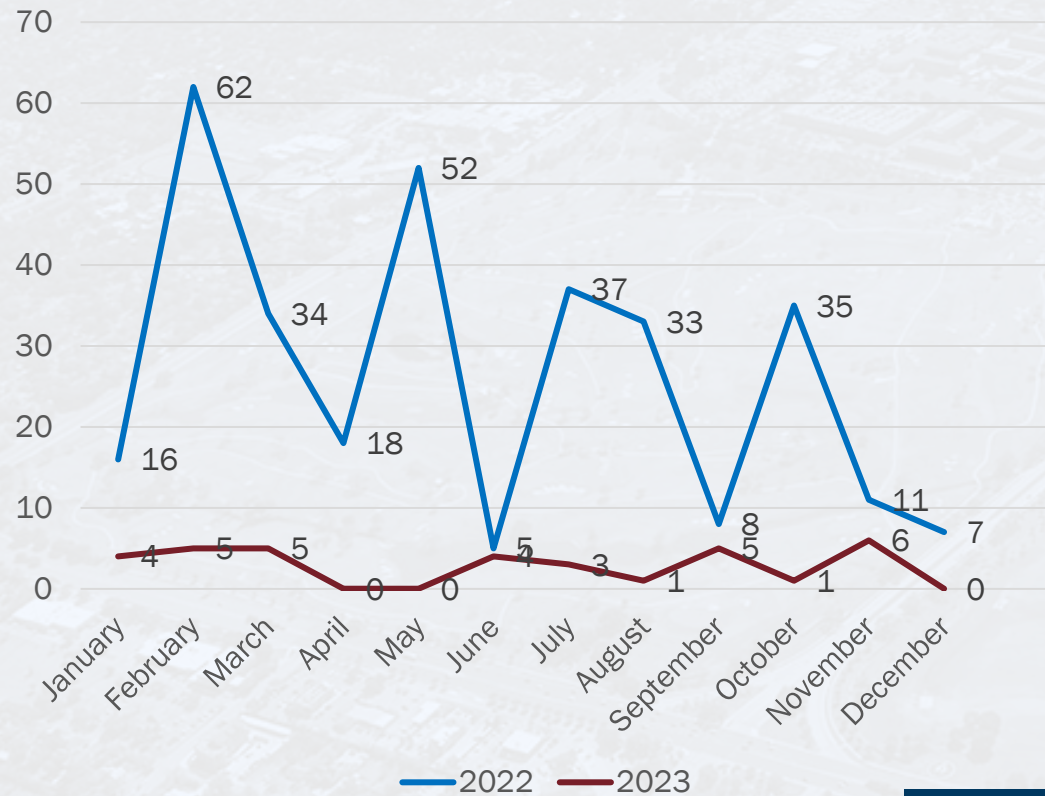

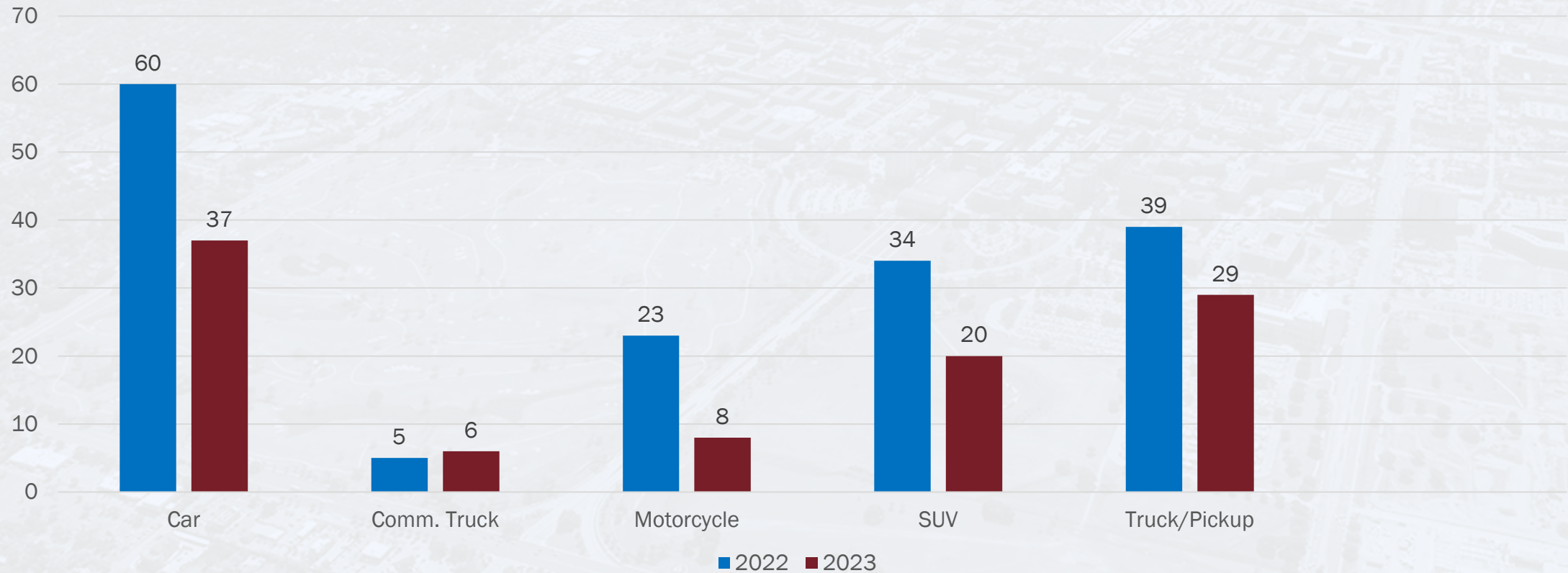

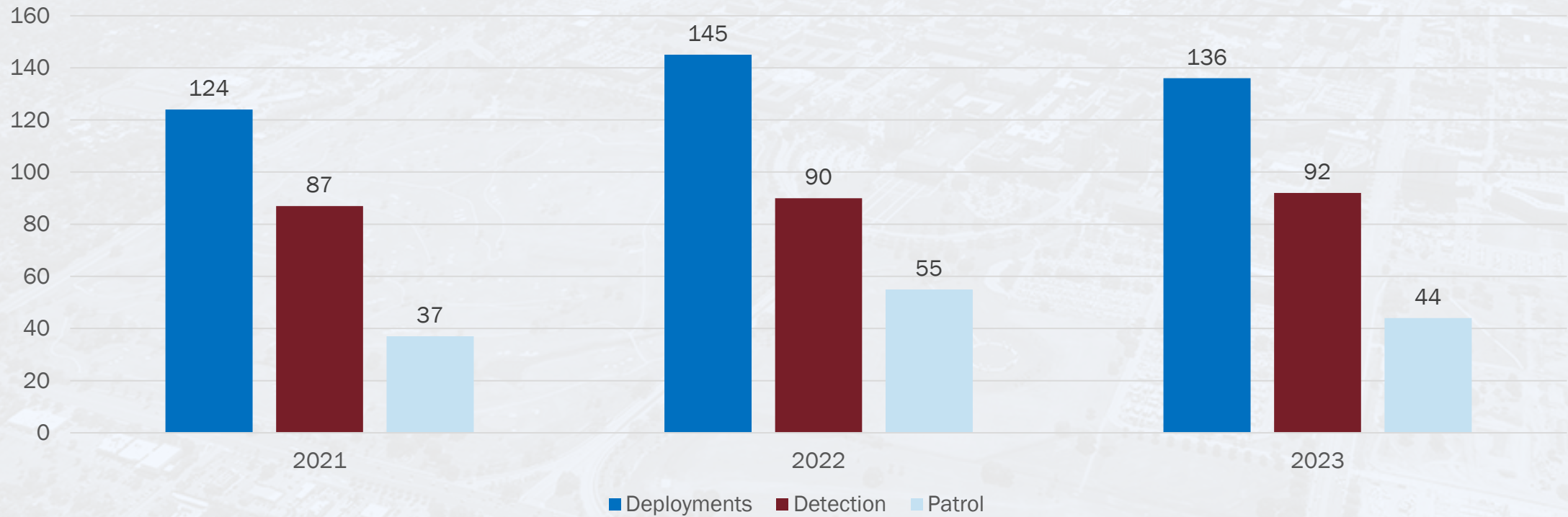
K9 Unit Training

- Foundational Training is four months through the Utah Post.
 - Canine and Handler focused training
 - Two months dedicated to Patrol
 - Two months dedicated to Narcotics
- Patrol
 - Handler Defense
 - Obedience
 - Neutrality to Gunfire
 - Handler Control
 - Tracking
 - Area Search for Persons
 - Evidence/ Article Recovery
 - Building Searches
 - Apprehension
- Narcotics Detection
 - Open area Grass or Wooded terrain
 - Buried Hides
 - Vehicle Hides / Interior or Exterior
 - Hides with high animal traffic
 - Hides within Buildings
 - Parcel or Luggage Hides



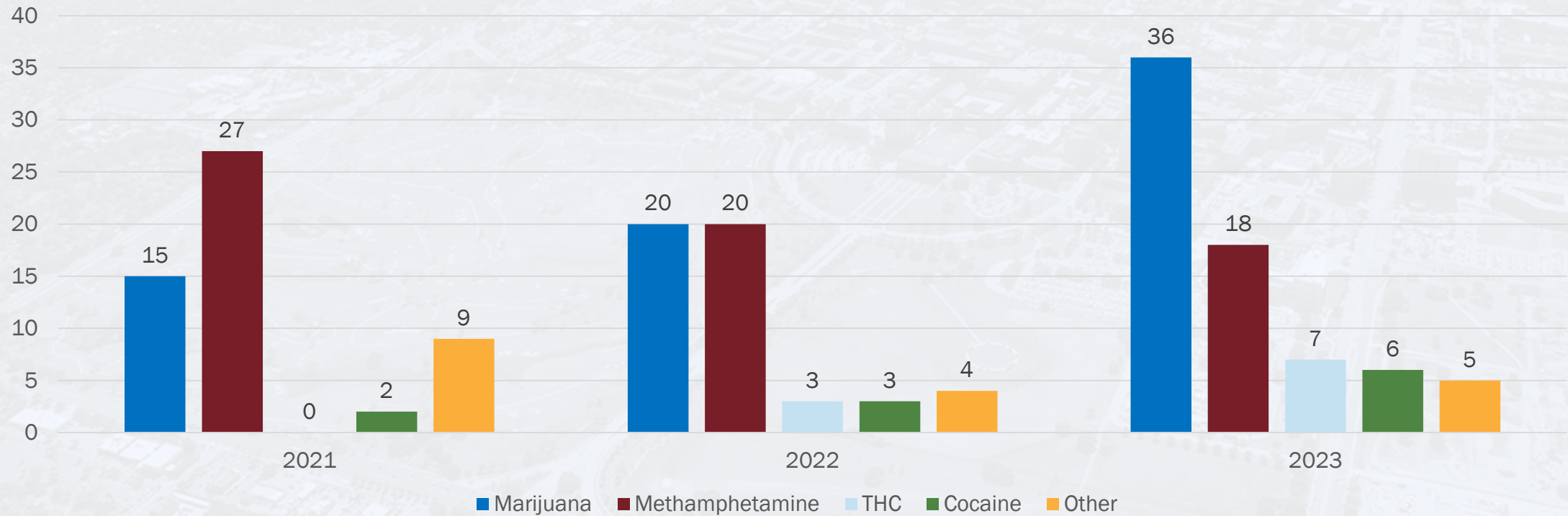

Annual Deployments



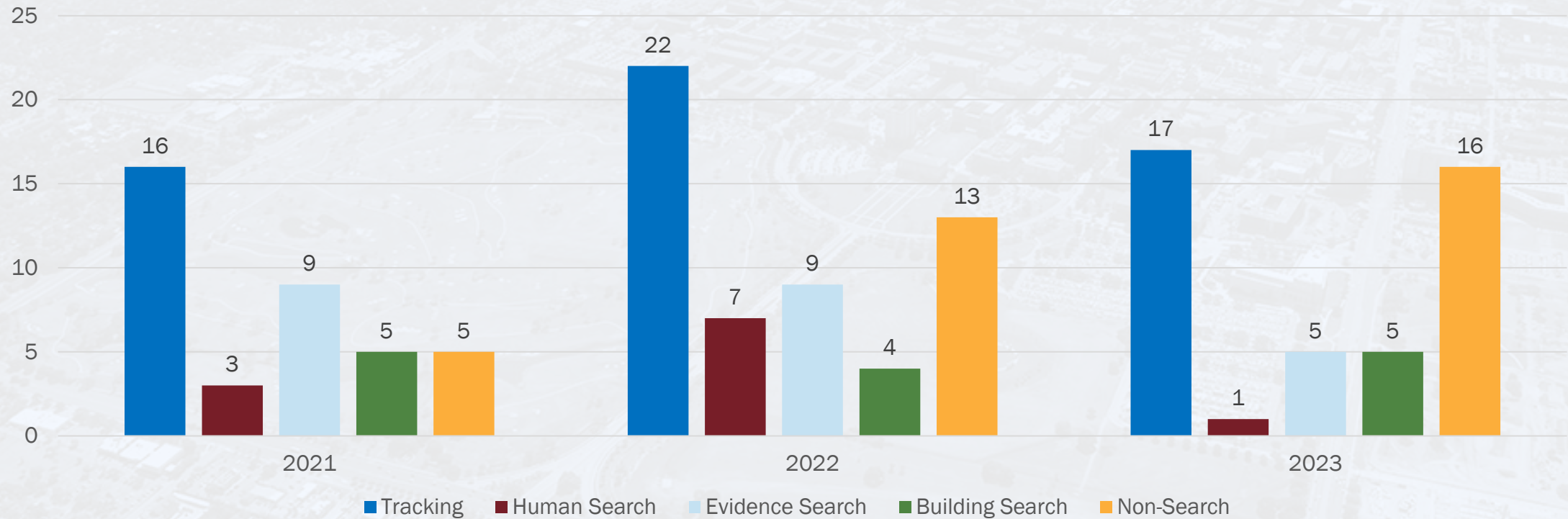

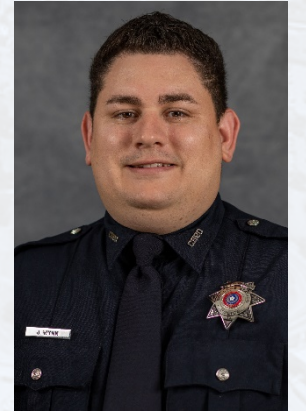
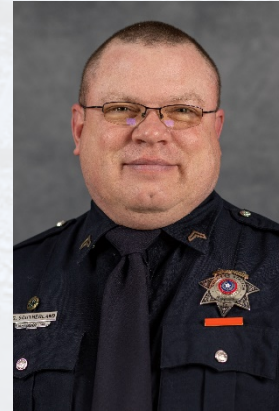
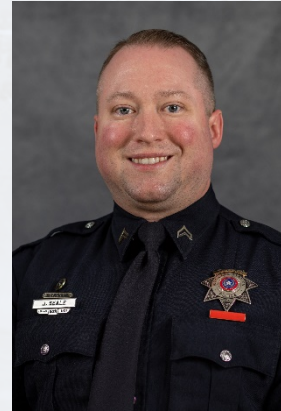
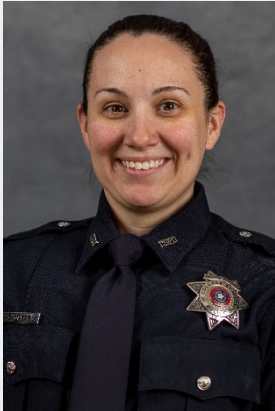
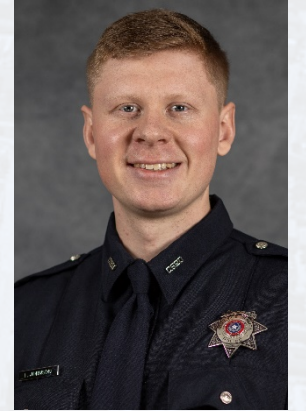
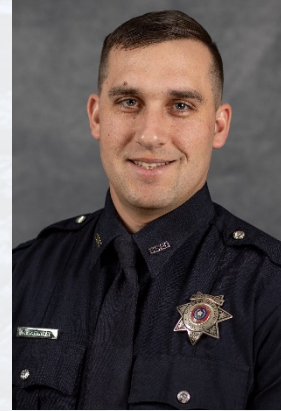
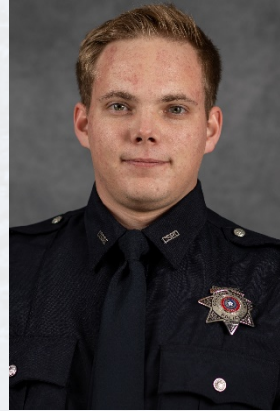
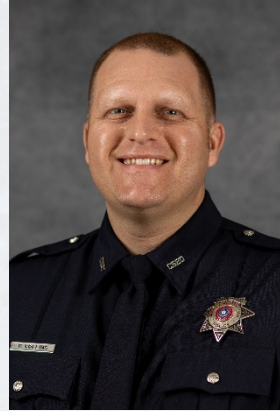


K9 Program Results

Item Seized	Amount Seized
Marijuana	139 seizure incidents = 14.6 Kilograms
Methamphetamine	122 seizure incidents = 2.8 Kilograms
Cocaine	30 seizure incidents = 350 Grams
THC	15 seizure incidents = 972 Grams
MDMA	15 seizure incidents = 65 grams
Heroin	5 seizure incidents = 26 grams
Hashish	5 seizure incidents = 478 grams
Mushrooms	3 seizure incidents = 74 grams
LSD	2 seizure incidents = 2 grams
Other	9 seizure incidents = 210 grams

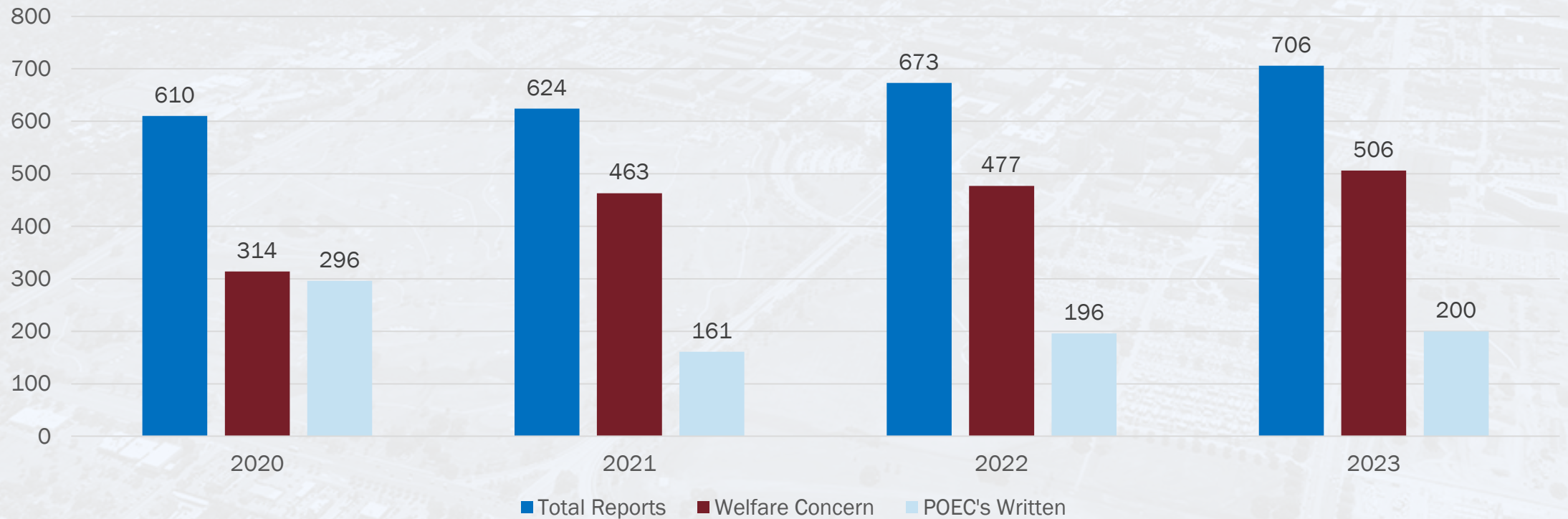
Crisis Intervention Training

- Current Police officers receive a 40-hour course in the Police Academy on Crisis Intervention Training
- In 2018-2019 we trained all officers in our organization on this same material
 - Solidified the department culture for addressing people with mental health disorders
 - The majority of calls involving mental health consumers are taken by patrol officers as a matter of routine.
- Our Crisis Intervention Team receive additional training to become certified Mental Health Peace Officers
 - These officers respond to a handle the more unique or challenging calls involving mental health consumers.



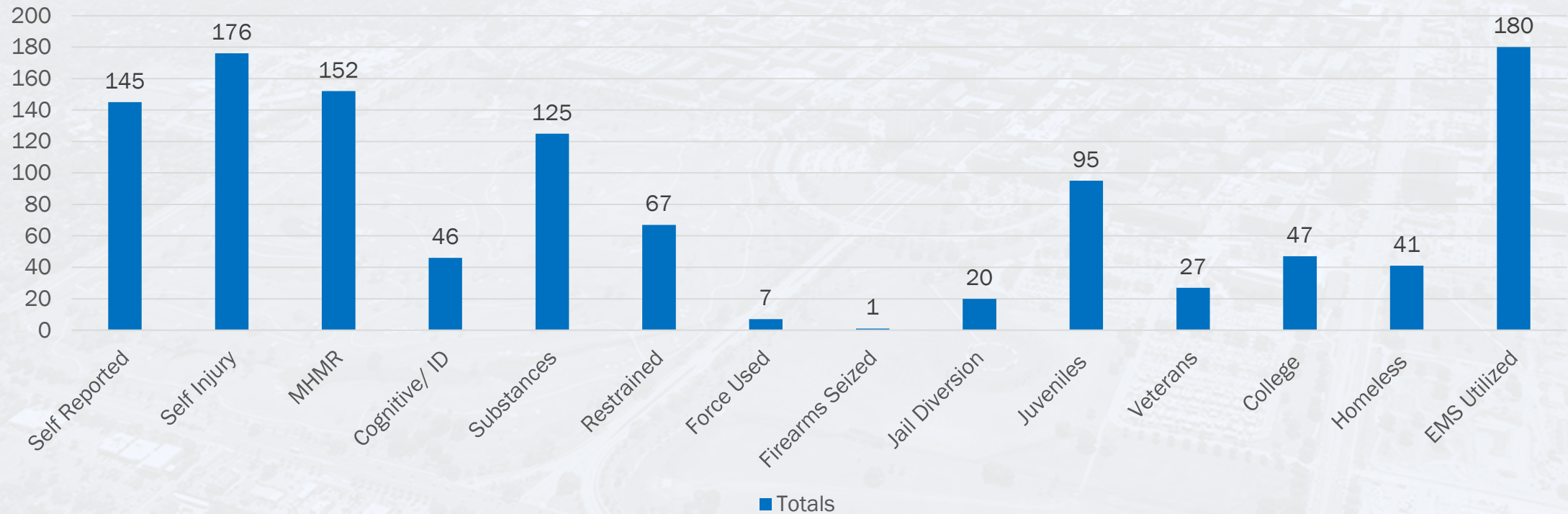
