Current Conditions



- Completed in 2018
- Raised trail and provided second access/exit in 2023



Challenges



- Sight distance
- Down hill, lower volume can lead to higher vehicle speeds
- Risk with at-grade and mid-block crossings higher than separated crossings

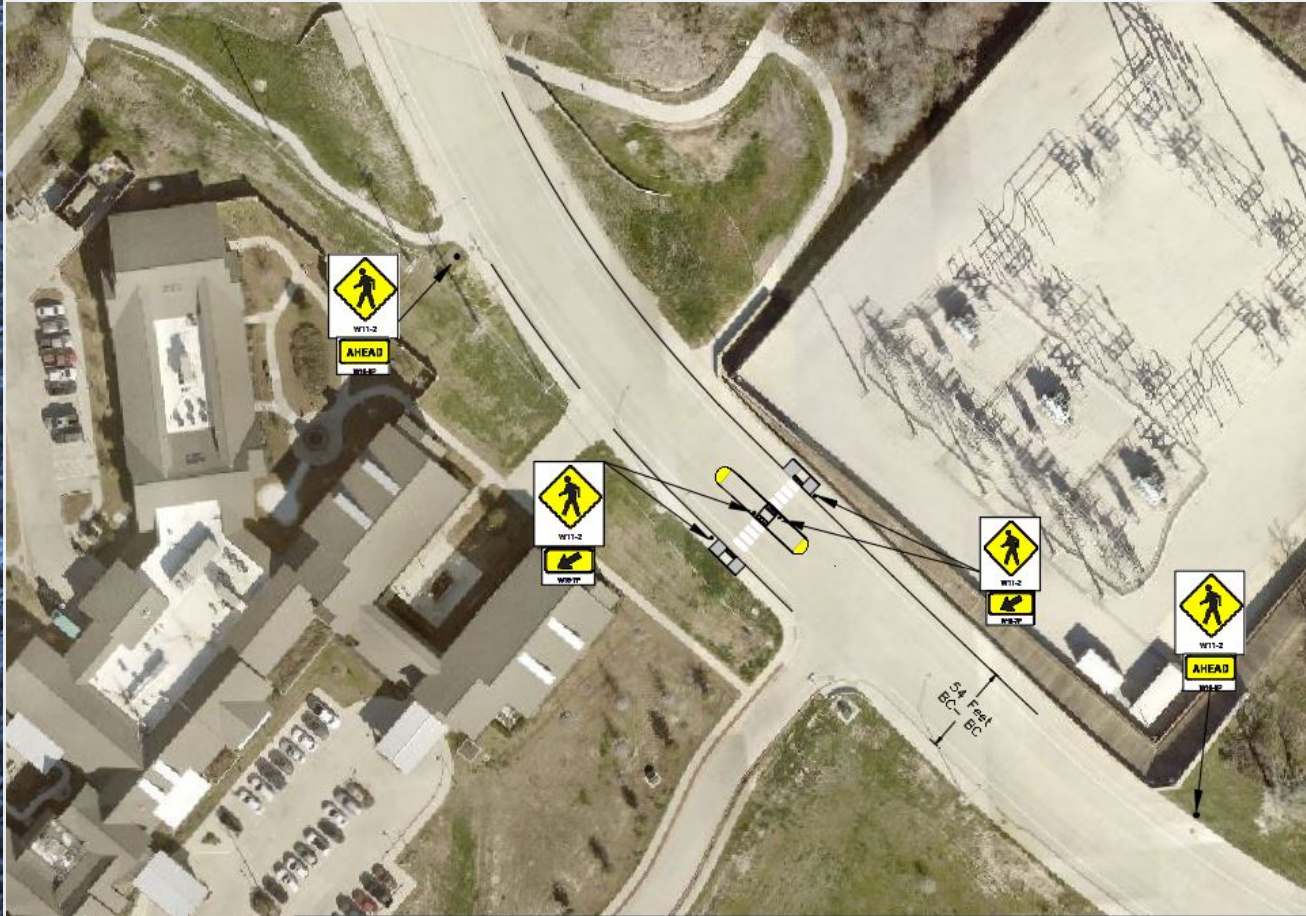


Options

- Continue utilizing trail underpass
- High visibility pedestrian crossing with median refuge at-grade near the intersection of Midtown Drive and Carroll Fancher Way
 - Estimated cost \$70,000
- High visibility pedestrian crossing at-grade with median refuge and rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFB) near the trail access points
 - Estimated cost \$120,000



Option – Crossing at Carroll Fancher



- High visibility crossing with median refuge
- Can be built to accommodate RRFBs in the future with higher traffic demand
