### **6.2 FY25 Annual Exemptions**

**Question:** "Per carcass fee for 1 to 19 animal carcasses collected from a commercial veterinarian, plus a flat rate service charge of \$25.25. The flat rate service charge is waived for 20 or more animal carcasses collected at one time."

Quote is from page 290, but it doesn't state what the per carcass fee IS..... Can you please review this and let me know what the per carcass fee IS and where that is listed.

**Response:** The per carcass fee is listed on page 288 of the agenda packet. The per carcass fee is \$25.25 for the first 19 carcasses, plus the flat fee of an additional \$25.25.
