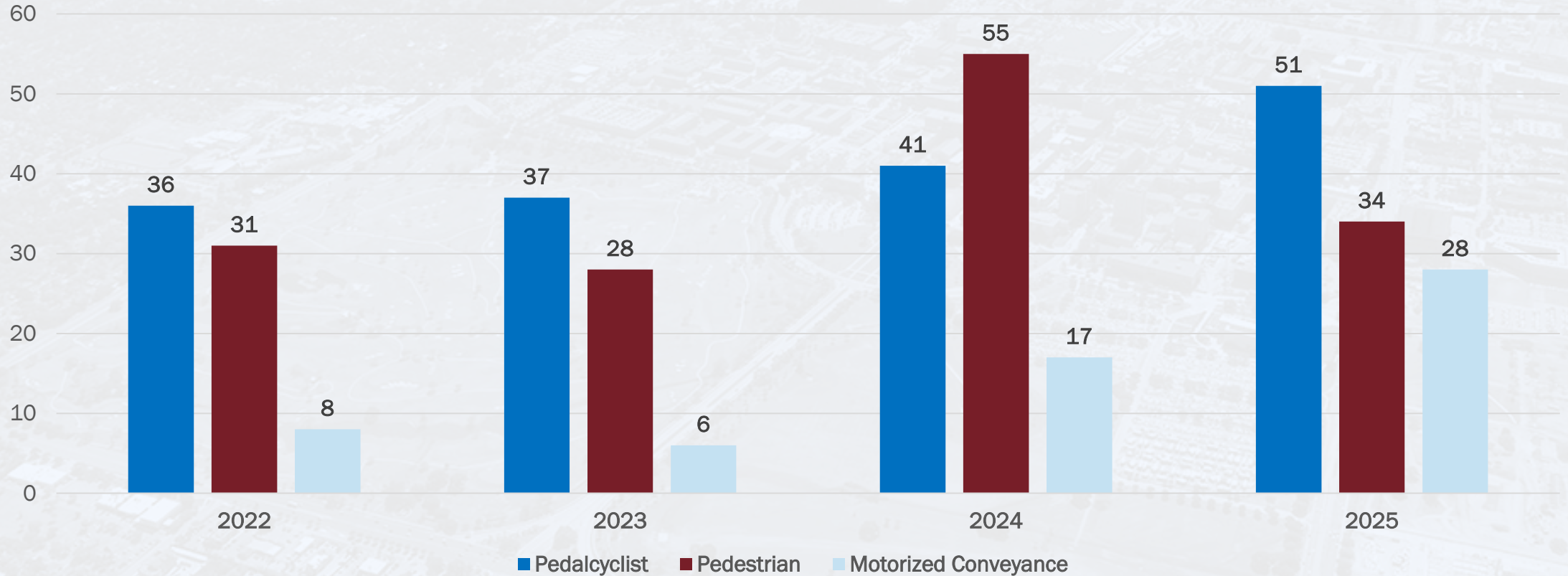

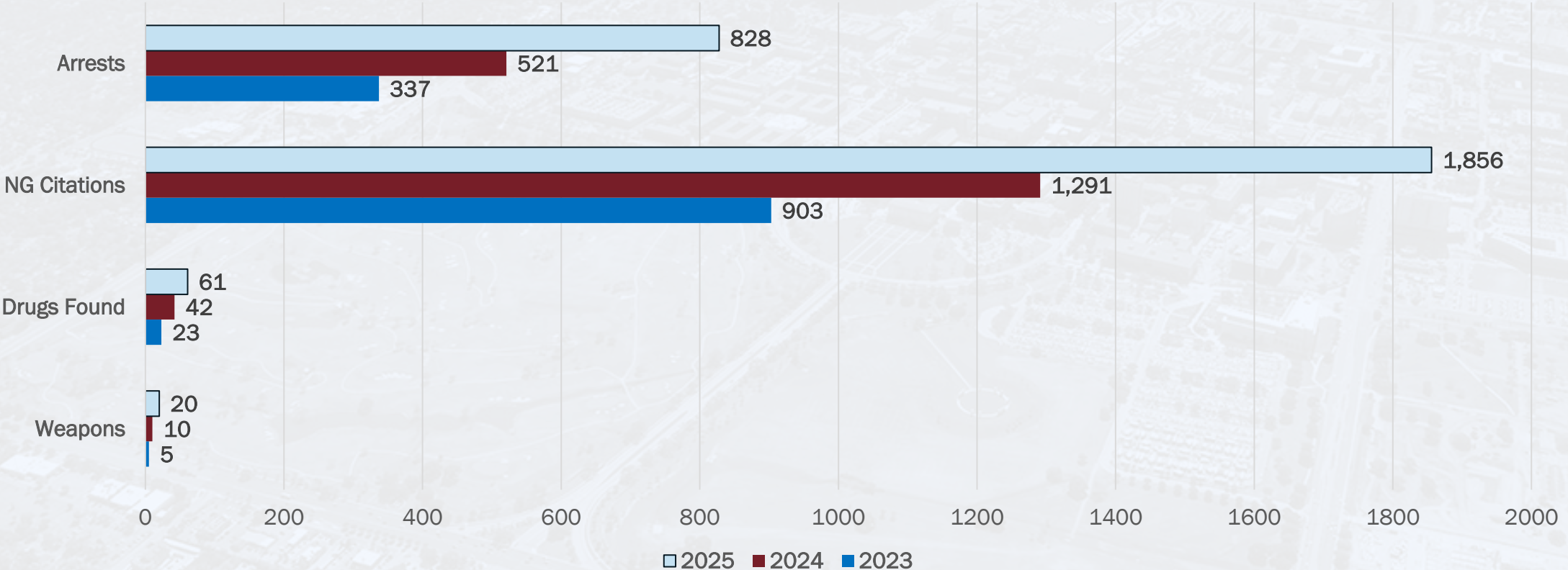

# Pedestrian Crash Information

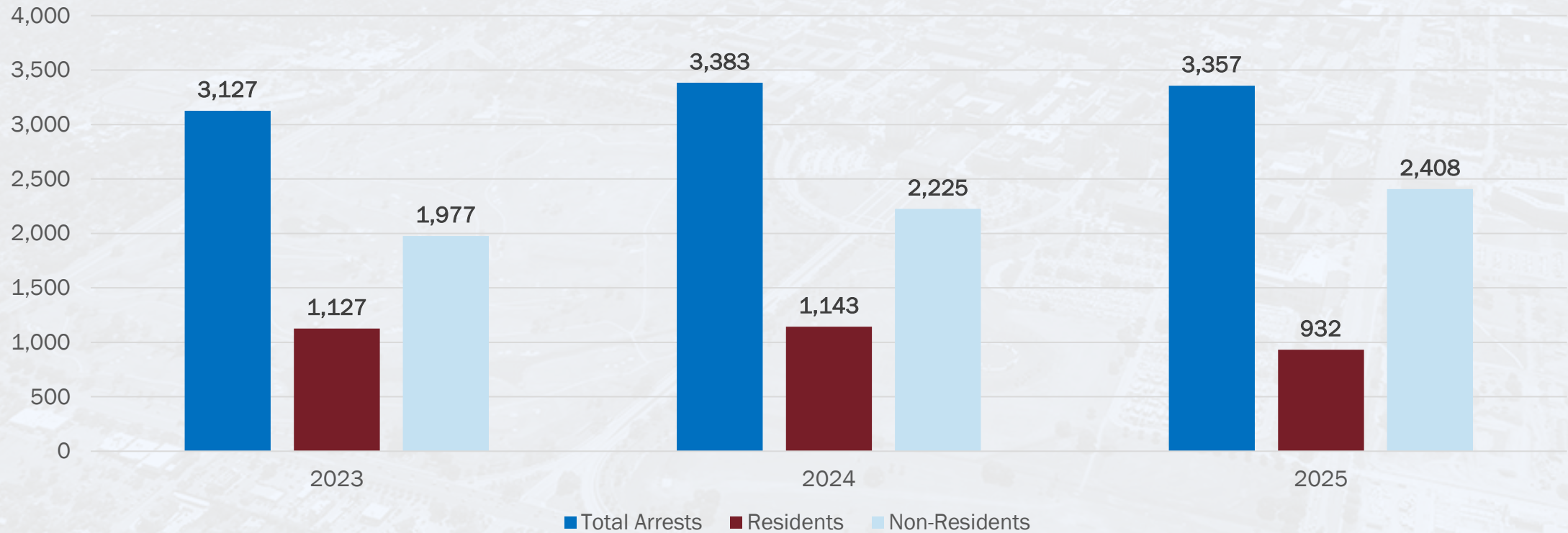

- Warnings 18,169

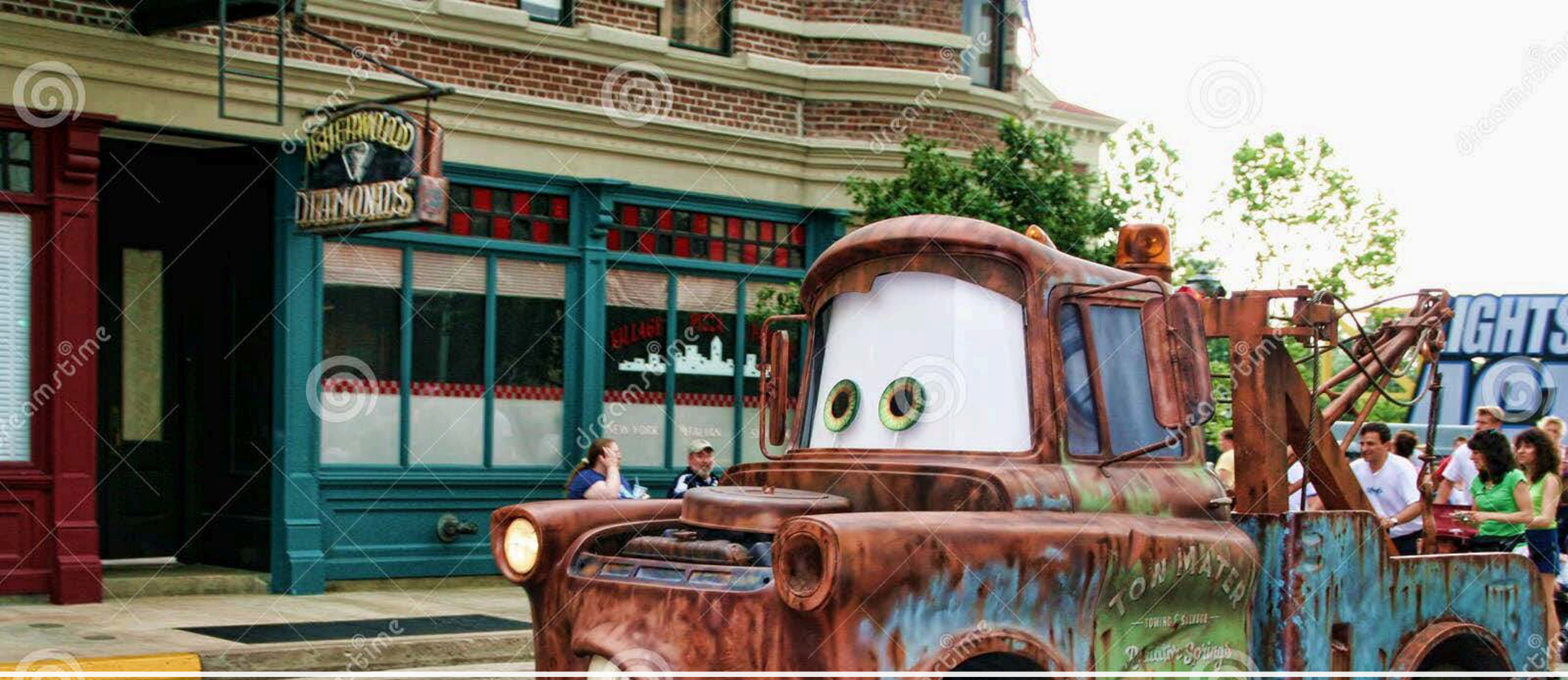


# **(2025) Traffic Contact Analysis**

- Most traffic contacts were made with males
- Most contacts were with Whites
- Police Officers did not know the race or ethnicity of the individual prior to the stop, in most cases.
- The most frequent reason for a stop was moving traffic violations.
- Most contacts took place on “City streets”

# (2025) Traffic Contact Analysis

- Most stops did not involve a search
- Of those searches made, most were made with “probable cause”
- Contraband was located in approximately half of the searches
- Of the contraband found, drugs were the most frequent

## Private Property Tow

- Non-Consent Tow
- Authorized by parking facility owner
- Wrecker of choice
- Predatory Practices
